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### Blood Glucose Curve

A blood glucose curve is done to help regulate and to monitor the treatment of diabetic patients. Your pet will be hospitalized for the day and serial blood sugar levels will be evaluated every 2-3 hours throughout the day. Your veterinarian will evaluate the results of this glucose curve to determine if insulin dosage changes are required or further testing is needed.
